The biggest problem in all this is that unless I'd been "tapped-in" to the ways & means by which the Lord operates, and I'm sure I don't yet even know the half of it, I would have missed realizing where all my blessings were coming from. I think this is true of most people, and I think one thing that really helps us grow in faith is when we count our blessings daily.

When it comes to building our Faith, one step at a time, noone does it better than the Lord Himself. I know it's important to weather storms and stay in faith whenever they come, I know that builds and reinforces character. But I also think there are multiple ways to do that, and I know the Lord's ways are always amazing. He knows exactly how to build up our faith. And I believe He does it differently for each one of us. That's how much He loves us!

It's remarkable how when we keep a thankful perspective, it changes everything.
