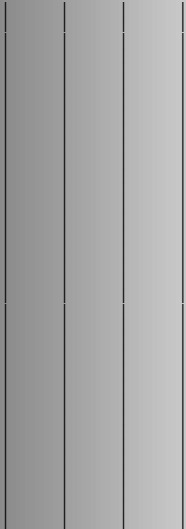

*Balancing the Scales of Justice
for Young People and Their Communities*



The underlying rationales of the Juvenile Court system are that the youth are different from adults and that their behavior is malleable. Rehabilitation and treatment, in addition to community protection, are considered to be primary goals.

A juvenile offender is judged to be “delinquent”, rather than “guilty”. And because of the individualized nature of the Juvenile Justice system, disposition varies and may cover a wide range of community-based and residential options.

The disposition is based on the individual’s offense history and the severity of the offense, and includes a significant rehabilitation component.

Alternatives to detention may be considered in lieu of punishment in some cases.
